Inga's Travel Packing List

My list reflects my style, which is comfortable and casual without being sloppy and light weight. I can fit everything for a week or a month in one roller bag carryon and a computer pack. Your needs will vary based on the trip. Here is a selection I've used and loved. Most items are middle-of-the-road prices.

Laptop Backpack

- Targus Cypress Slim Backpack 15.6 inch (short trips)
 - The <u>Targus Cypress Slim Backpack</u> is what I use when I want a pack only for my laptop, phone and travel documents. It has a low profile and is lightweight.
- Targus Corporate Traveler Backpack 15.6 inch (longer trips).
 - The <u>Targus Corporate Traveler Backpack</u> a larger pack that is similar in design to discontinued North Face and Swiss Gear packs I've used. It has two or three roomy compartments with enough storage to pack all my cords, toiletries and clothing for an overnight. I use this style pack for trips of a week or longer when I need more capacity.

Suitcase

- Travel Pro Maxlite
 - The <u>Travel Pro Maxlite</u> is my go-to suitcase that is lightweight, can fit in an overhead compartment on a plane and can hold everything I need for a week anywhere or a month in warm climates.

Basics for Every Trip

These go in my suitcase first:

- Trail runner shoes (Altra Timps) or hiking boots (Merrell Moab Ventilator)
- Workout clothing (synthetic quick dry)
 - Shorts or leggings
 - Short sleeve shirt
- Socks
- Underwear/bra
- Sleep shirt
- Tea bags in a zip top baggie (I'm a tea drinker and many places don't stock tea)
- Small purse
- Light pack for hiking (REI Flash 18)
